Effect: 3 months additional progress

• Support students in their literacy development (one on one tutition)

Effect: 5 months additional progress

(reading comprehension)

Effect: 6 months additional progress

Our initiatives include

- ✓ Reading/Writing Intervention one on one for students who are identified at risk from data collected (early start – literacy continuum, summative assessment items, reading individual tests)
- ✓ Purchasing of more teacher time to sustain three classrooms (P/1/2, 3/4, 5/6) and maintain small class numbers

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- ✓ Funding of teacher aides to do ongoing literacy intervention throughout the week, every term, all year long (\$ 7,000)
- ✓ Funding towards our third teacher (\$ 7, 258)
